This Friday We Celebrate Dr Seuss!

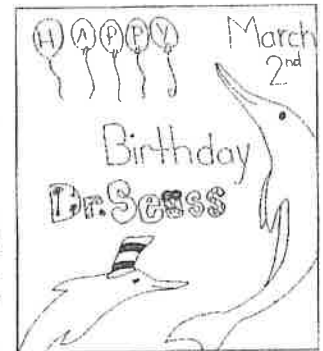
The LdV Seussian Players have been hard at work on a play from the book, "The Sneetches". You are welcome to join us for the fun in the gym at 9 am.

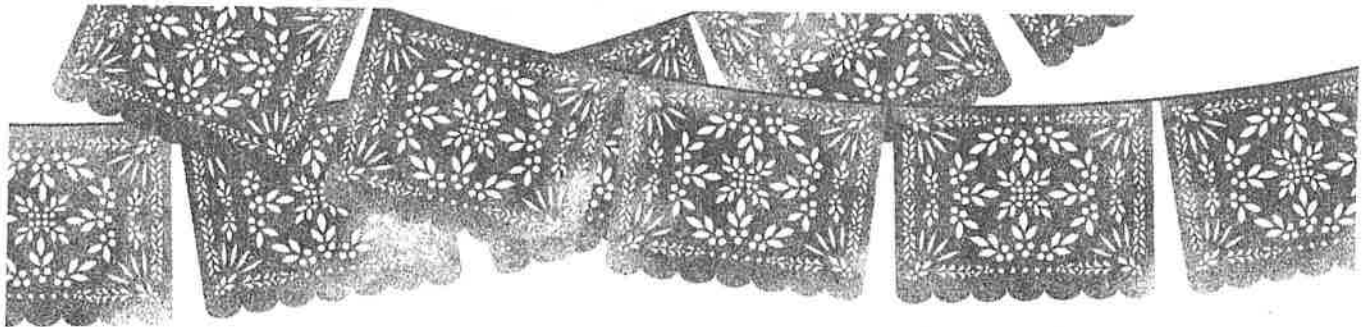

Attendance Information

Please email torreso@scusd.edu with your students' absences and tardies or call 395-4636. By email or phone, leave the child's name, room number, date of absence and reason for being out of school (i.e.: illness, doctor appointment, religious, out of town, death in family). Please use "absence" in the subject line of your email. You will receive a reply if your email has been received. Absence verification must be made daily. Doctor's notes must accompany any medical excuse including tardies and early dismissals over 30 minutes. Unverified absences will result in truancies.

Students are allowed 10 excused (illness with a parent's excuse, death in immediate family, child's appearance in court) absences per the year. Each additional absence from illness must have a doctor's note to be cleared.

Did You Know... When your child has chicken pox, a skin rash, lice or other infectious health challenges you need to follow up with the main office when your child returns to campus. A doctor's note that the child has been treated and is okay to be back among our other students after a rash or chicken pox is required by SCUSD health services.

Late to School? Students who are over 30 minutes tardy must be accompanied to the main office by their parent or guardian to obtain a tardy slip. All tardies over 30 minutes must have an official doctor's note. Three tardies over 30 minutes without such documentation will result in a truancy notice.

Planning an Extended Absence? Your child may have an independent study package if you are planning an absence of more than three days. You must request a packet from the Main Office at least two weeks in advance of the absence. Please contact Oneida Torres in the main office with any questions torresO@scusd.edu

Student Medications If your child needs medications during the school day, a new medication form needs to be filed. Forms must be complete before any meds can be left.

Please Bring Your ID

If you are taking your child for early dismissal or are sending someone from your emergency card list, please note ID will be required. It is school policy to show proper ID before a student is released. It is for the safety of your child, please do not grouse at the staff who are keeping our children safe!

(School Community Liaison)

Badges: Every parent on campus must sign in to the main office. If you are working anywhere on campus get a "Volunteer" badge and sign in the Volunteer book. Tally Sheets: Please turn Tally Sheets into your child's class or to the Volunteer Office at the end of the month.

Carry Over Hours: Hours from 2016-17 are only carried over to this year if they were worked AFTER May 15, 2017 (and turned in). Thank you to every parent who worked over their requested hours last year (most of you). Our program shines because of you!

TB test results and Sex Offender Background check clearances: Must be on file before working in the classroom. Fingerprinting must be cleared before driving on or chaperoning fieldtrips.

Fingerprinting Requirements

Yes, you do need to be fingerprinted to go on a field trip...whether you are driving children or not...whether you are going by bus or not. The District requires any adult who is not fingerprinted to be in sight of a certificated person at all times, but it is vital that teachers be free to watch their students, not the grown ups who are there to help. So fingerprint please!

Driving on a Field Trip?

The district requirements for insurance (when driving kids on field trips) are as follows: minimum of liability \$50,000/\$100,000 and property is minimum \$25,000.
